TORRANCE is a four-piece creative rock band led by the ethereal vocals and sharp vision of Tamara Williamson, whose songwriting blends lyrical vulnerability with bold sonic landscapes. With Mitchell Girio (bass, producer, mixing), Cassie Jones (vocals, keys), and the dynamic support of drummers past and present, Torrance occupies a rich and deeply textured corner of the Canadian indie music scene.

Their latest release, SET LIST, is both a retrospective and a renewal — a living mixtape of their evolution, drawing from decades of recordings and collaborations, unified by the band's unmistakable creative chemistry. The album drops June 11, 2025, with the uplifting single "UP UP" launching May 27.

Built from the bones of previous incarnations of Mrs. Torrance and Tamara Williamson, SET LIST is an emotional journey told in 11 original tracks. It features recordings from as far back as 1997 to fresh 2025 sessions at Slowcooker, the band's creative hub. From the dreamy resilience of "STILL HERE" to the thunderous self-confrontation in "MIRROR HORSE," these are songs that live on stage — and in memory.

Produced and mastered across years and studios — Slowcooker, Modest Heights, and The Film House — SET LIST was lovingly assembled by Tamara, Mitchell, and Stephen to reflect the songs currently performed live. The album's cover, captured by Roger Carlsen, visually echoes the music's intimacy and motion.

"This is another song about love..." Tamara sings on the lead single "UP UP," a declaration of hope, transformation, and emotional lift-off. It's a welcome invitation to let go of gravity — even if just for a few minutes — and fly.
